

Offshore Skills Assessment Program – (OSAP)			
Purpose	The OSAP program is for applicants who need a skills assessment as part of their skilled migration visa application to the Department of Home Affairs. The OSAP outcome shows if you have the skills and experience needed at the required level to work in Australia in your nominated occupation.		
Assessment Process	Documentary evidence for eligibility	<p>Evidence of at least 5 years full time paid employment in a directly related trade, including evidence of at least 12 months full time paid employment in the nominated trade in the last 3 years before the date of application.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copies of your formal training qualifications (if applicable) • Colour copy of photo identification (passport required) • Colour copies of licenses/permits (if applicable) • Colour copies of employer statements • Two forms of pay evidence for each year claimed; 3 pay slips per year, Superannuation statements, bank deposits referenced to employer • Two passport-sized photographs • Current Resume/work history 	AUD \$1,120 – paid to TRA via the candidate’s online account
