Complete the Visa Skills - Expressions of Interest including:

- 1. Candidate details
- 2. Trade and relevant Skills Assessment Program

Stage 1 - Documentary Assessment

Complete submission of documentary evidence and upload all requirements to portal. An Identifier code will be emailed for payment of Stage 1 Documentary Assessment.

Once payment is received, ACTS reviews all training and employment evidence to ensure you meet all TRA requirements.

Conduct the Documentary assessment.

Successful

Sufficient evidence to progress to the next stage of assessment.

Unsuccessful

Insufficient evidence to progress to the next stage of assessment. Unsuccessful Stage 1 outcomes are reviewed by TRA.

Candidate can:

- 1. Accept decision
- 2. Apply for reassessment
- 3. Apply for a review

Stage 2 - Technical Assessment

A technical assessment will be open in the portal. Evidence will need to be supplied for each of the practical components in the form of video's photos, workplace documents and or scan tool reports.

Once complete you will receive a stage 2 payment email (Progress to technical interview)

Once payment is made, you will be scheduled an interview date and time.

Successful Outcome

You will receive an Australian qualification in the nominated trade and a successful outcome letter for the purpose of your visa/ migration.

Unsuccessful Outcome

You will receive an unsuccessful assessment outcome letter and if applicable a Statement of Attainment (units found competent in).
