Purpose	rss skills assessments are designed to determine if applicants have the skills and experience necessary to work in Australia at the trade level for heir occupation so they can contribute immediately to the Australian workforce.		
Assessment Process	Documentary evidence for eligibility	Evidence of at least 5 years full time paid employment in a directly related trade, including evidence of at least 12 months full time paid employment in the nominated trade in the last 3 years before the date of application.  Copies of your formal training qualifications (if applicable) Colour copy of photo identification (passport required) Colour copies of licenses/permits (if applicable) Colour copies of employer statements Two forms of pay evidence for each year claimed; 3 pay slips per year, Superannuation statements, bank deposits referenced to employer Two passport-sized photographs Current Resume/work history	AUD \$1,120 – paid to TRA via the candidate's online account
